Tax barristers act for a varied client base including entrepreneurs, owner-managed businesses, large organisations, individuals, partnerships and companies, whether based in the UK or overseas. If not managed properly, HMRC enquiries can be prolonged and involve the production of significant volumes of (potentially irrelevant) information. Taxpayers should consider at each stage the relevance of HMRC's requests; prepare responses with an eye on potential litigation; and always be mindful of their right to seek closure. Barristers can provide a range of services, including advising their clients on the strengths and weaknesses of their case. Well versed tax barristers often act for tax advisers in defending claims and act as specialist consultants to other advisers. Most people who are tax resident in the UK pay income tax and CGT on their worldwide income and capital gains by reference to the tax year in which the income or gains arise. Tax barristers can provide advice on ownership structures, including joint ventures and special purpose vehicles. With the surge in tax risks, complex rules and regulations, interagency cooperation and real time communication between tax authorities there is an

increasing emphasis on evidencing behaviours through governance and documentation. Technical merit is no longer enough. As well as advising on traditional final salary schemes, some pension specialists have experience of defined contribution schemes, career average revalued earnings (CARE) schemes, and cash balance schemes and how they have been impacted by legislative changes, and dealing with the ever increasing governance requirements. The services of a tax barrister can include SDLT guidance on liability in complex property transactions and the availability of SDLT exemptions and reliefs, legitimately reducing SDLT liability where possible, managing HMRC enquiries and investigations and representing clients in SDLT appeals before tribunals and in court.
